ARCHIVAL ACTIVITIES

Dedicated volunteers have made a significant difference in the EHS Archives during 2019. We have processed and catalogued hundreds of photographs taken by freelance photographer Peter

Jones for The Georgetown Herald in the 1960s. The Georgetown Kinsmen Club and The Town of Halton Hills made large donations. The large Dills Family collection has been listed. Finally, a significant addition is a searchable index to the digital photographs on the DVDs received from the Independent Free Press. They cover digital images taken by the reporters beginning with the switch from film to digital about 1997 up to 2007.

Not everything we receive is related to Esquesing Township. Consequently, we transferred items from our collection to the Burlington Historical Society, Milton Historical Society and to the Archives of Canada. Other Archives do the same thing, so we received negatives taken at Smith and Stone in 1952, from the City of Toronto Archives and a series of 1955 street images of Acton, donated by the Bruce County Museum.

Thanks to Library staff, the finding aid for the Esquesing Historical Society can now be searched through the Archives Association of Ontario website, Archeion at www.archeion.ca/esquesinghistorical-society

The Archives and Library were fortunate some time ago to receive an 1856 map of Esquesing School Sections. It has been sent for restoration. The restored map will hang in the History Room of the Georgetown Library.


ARCHIVE USE

This year we had 1 931 users, down 191 users from last year. We had 2 757 sessions during the year. The most popular pages were the home page, Halton Images, about us, meetings & events, contact us, newsletters, communities, publications and specifically the historical article, "Origin of Georgetown Street Names."

Users were from Canada 76%, U.S. 19%, United Kingdom 1% followed by China, Poland, Australia, South Korea, France, Japan and Germany.
